You have asked me to confirm what I told you last Thursday and Friday with respect to the possible further analysis by the UCLA Olympic Laboratory of seven (7) B samples from the Tour de France. What I told you was that UCLA could not perform that work at the present time and that it is very very unlikely that UCLA could perform that work before May 14, 2007. We have had a mechanical breakdown on our IRMS instrument. We were in the process of reviewing our procedure in connection with the instrument work and that process has been delayed by my resignation as Laboratory Director last Friday March 23.
